## PersonalBrain 6 Release History

---

PersonalBrain 6 is a **paid upgrade** from PersonalBrain 5. If you purchased a new license of PersonalBrain 5 (not including upgrades) after February 1, 2010, sign up for the [free upgrade](#). **Note:** Opening a Brain in PersonalBrain 6 makes irreversible changes to your Brain database, making it incompatible with version 5.5. If you want the option to go back to version 5.5, you must make a backup of your Brain prior to opening it with PersonalBrain 6.

Note: Publishing and synchronization of files via WebBrain.com is subject to additional monthly fees.

### Version 6.0.7.9

February 23, 2012

- Faster Sync, especially when many links have been modified
- Fixed: Some Brains cannot be opened due to errors while repairing favicons (a different issue from the 6.0.7.8 fix)
- Fixed: Untyping of Thoughts may not be synced

### Version 6.0.7.8

February 8, 2012

- Updated version of notes editor. Fixes image copy and paste issues on Mac OS X.
- Fixed: Some Brains cannot be opened due to errors while repairing favicons.

### Version 6.0.7.7

February 1, 2012

- Fixed: Google Calendar sync issue with recurring events.
- Fixed: Favicon files may be stored twice and the favicon may not show next to the Thought
- Fixed: The default name for URLs may not be the correct part of the domain name
- Fixed: Favicons cannot be found from Brains that have been opened in version 7

- Updated Dutch localization
- Fixed: Hangs on Windows shutdown if docked
- Fixed: Notes editor sometimes puts the cursor in the wrong position after pressing the home key (#1894)

- Fixes
  - Fixed: Shutdown of Windows can cause PersonalBrain to hang

  - Fixed: Spellcheck sometimes incorrectly highlights words as if they are misspelled

  - Fixed: Changing the dictionary clears the content of the current note (occurred only in the 6.0.7.2 test release)

- Added Portuguese translation, including tips
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Editor icons display incorrectly in Mac OS X Lion
  - Fixed: Problem with opening a thought URL to an already opened brain
  - Fixed: Virtual thought pins do not display after a brain is closed and opened
  - Fixed: Renaming an attachment can cause an assigned icon to disappear
  - Fixed: Graphics copied and pasted from one note to another are changed
  - Fixed: In notes, the text cursor does not change color if the notes colors are changed
  - Fixed: If you attempt to move a file into your Brain which is no longer in its original location, sometimes the progress tracker appears above the message box

### **Version 6.0.7.1**

- Fixed: Possible problem restoring BrainZips from brains created using version 6.0.6.7 or 6.0.6.8
- Fixed: Removal of wallpaper does not sync to WebBrain, changes to wallpaper are not received from WebBrain

- Compatibility with the new version of WebBrain
- Fixed: When opening a Brain created in version 6.0.6.7 or 6.0.6.8, sometimes an unnecessary error message is displayed.

### **Version 6.0.6.9**

April 18, 2011

- Fixed: Version metadata inconsistencies in Brains created by version 6.0.6.8 and 6.0.6.7 could cause system notes not to be saved properly and may result in problems related to WebBrain and Google Calendar sync functions. This problem applies only to Brains that were created by version 6.0.6.8 or 6.0.6.7. These problems are fixed automatically by this release.

### **Version 6.0.6.8**

April 15, 2011

- Fixes
  - Fixed: The thought type icon does not override attachment based icons on instances of the type
  - Fixed: Paste of multiple URLs from text files or notes into attachments sometimes does not work
  - Fixed: Can't click on checkboxes in floating notes windows
  - Fixed: Sync should be stopped when a brain is closed
  - Fixed: Problems with detecting registration in some cases on Windows XP (cause problems with spellchecking, insert table in notes, and other pro/core-only features)
  - Fixed: Problems with attachment list display when there are no files, but there are URLs (when one URL is deleted, others also disappear temporarily even though they are not really gone)
  - Fixed: Wallpaper does not work if brain is stored in a location with non-Latin characters
  - Fixed: A thought's external attachment gets deleted if it is a single attachment

### **Version 6.0.6.7**

April 7, 2011

- Faster Instant Activate
  - Finding thoughts using the instant activate search is up to 10 times faster. (This also speeds the process of creating Thoughts)
- Updated Dutch and German localizations
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Deleting a link can sometimes cause a hang due to the inability to click on the dialog box which appears behind the progress bar
  - Fixed: Sometimes icons do not update on cut and paste of files
  - Fixed: Calendar taskbar buttons on Mac should not have an outline

- Removed redundant calls to update attachments list
- Fixed: Attachment sort preference causes problems when switching languages
- Fixed: When renaming a thought and selecting all text then typing, the thought type and tags changes are not applied

#### Version 6.0.6.4

- Enhancements
  - A progress bar is displayed when attachments are being copied/moved during copy/paste and drag and drop operations.
  - Advanced search values now get reset only after a new regular search has been performed.
  - Updated French, German and Chinese localizations
  - Only one error message is displayed if unable to delete multiple files.
  - Sync downloads data in chunks to ensure that large downloads complete and can be resumed
  - Better handling of brain:// links from 3<sup>rd</sup> party applications on Windows o{\*>
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Google calendar sync problems caused by date parsing and unnecessary white spaces.
  - Fixed: Text for reminder after one year is plural.
  - Fixed: Problem with import of outline.
  - Deletion of multiple files at a time is more reliable.
  - Fixed: On failure to delete multiple files, a separate message is displayed for each file.
  - Clarified WebBrain error message when user account cannot be validated.

#### Version 6.0.6.3

January 18, 2011

- Sync
  - Resumes interrupted upload of sync data
  - When an upload is interrupted, shows the amount of data uploaded
  - Added "Sync now" checkbox to sync dialog so that sync settings can be modified without initiating a sync
- Enhancements
  - When pasting an outline, paths to attachments are added as external attachments, just like URLs
  - On copy/paste of files when there is an existing file conflict, a "yes to all" option is available
  - Moves themes to user directory so that themes can be modified without needing administrator level access
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Context-clicks in calendar are not detected on Mac OS X
  - Fixed: In some situations, the snooze button can't be clicked
  - Fixed: When an event is deleted in PB but modified in Google Calendar, problems can occur
  - Fixed: If a Brain name has the '#' character in it, problems can happen with export
  - Fixed: Issue with customized notes CSS files and WebBrain
  - Fixed: About dialog does not show user name properly if foreign characters are included
  - Fixed: Changes to pins made via drag and drop are not saved
  - Various language resource fixes
  - Fixed: Problem with tools tab names not being localized in 6.0.6.2
  - Fixed: Right-click on empty attachment area does not show context menu
  - Fixed: On paste/duplicate/import of a Thought, the creation and modification dates are not set to the current time, but the times of the originating thought
  - Fixed: "Insert Table" does not work after "Open Notes Window" on the active thought

#### Version 6.0.6.2

- Updated French localization
- Minor Enhancements
  - New utility to check for modified attachments throughout a Brain
    - This should be done prior to sync if internal file attachments within a Brain have been modified using a 3<sup>rd</sup> party utility

- The sorting preference for attachments is saved
- Drag and drop to virtual Thoughts is now supported
- The [Enter] key can be used to activate a Thought in the selection
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Deleting a tag while in expanded view shows the tag after it has been deleted
  - Fixed: Tables in notes disappear after activating another thought if there is no other content
  - Fixed: Setting the sort option to "modified" in the Thought tool renders the "Select Attachment to Open" Window inoperable
  - Fixed: Thought Type menu is not drawn correctly on Mac OS sometimes
  - Fixed: Sometimes duplicate attachments appear on a Thought
  - Fixed: Some URLs don't show the correct favicons in some cases
  - Fixed: The "include index" option should not be displayed when exporting to folders
  - Fixed: Photoshop shows a "null" entry in the Add Attachment dialog
  - Fixed: Changing the UI language resets the tools layout
  - Fixed: Past Thought List scroll button does not show in the correct spot sometimes
  - Fixed: Thoughts show twice in the plex during mouseover of links in certain cases
  - Updated notes editor library
  - Increased timeout tolerance when downloading sync information and added additional troubleshooting information to logs
- Mac OS Specific Fixes
  - Improved coloring of search results and calendar tabs
  - Fixed: Address icons do not show properly in some cases
  - Fixed: Export to folders does not work in some cases

#### **Version 6.0.6.1**

- Improvements
  - Faster loading of Brains with many tags
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Wallpaper sometimes does not load when switching between brains
  - Fixed: Advanced search filtering by Thought type does not work
  - Fixed: Sometimes changes to wallpaper are not synced to WebBrain
  - Fixed: Typo in installer text

#### **Version 6.0.6.0**

November 29, 2010

- Added support for a new command line parameter (-n) to force a new instance of PersonalBrain
- WebBrain Sync Fixes
  - Fixed: Problems related to sync of types
  - Fixed: Can't login to WebBrain using an email address
  - Fixed: When tags are removed, their removal is not synced. Note: Tag removals done with prior releases of PersonalBrain will not sync even with the force sync command and must be manually removed.
- General Fixes
  - Fixed: Hyperlinks not showing in notes on exported simple HTML brains
  - Fixed: Does not always ensure every system attribute has been created during startup.
  - Fixed: The tip about filtering is incorrect

#### **Version 6.0.5.9**

November 23, 2010

- Fixes
  - Fixed: When there is a positive failure to authenticate with WebBrain, a retry should not be initiated
  - Fixed: WebBrain Sync error messages should not be displayed until retrying has completed
- Windows Specific
  - Context menu does not disappear on second press of menu key
  - Outlook messages do not replace any existing note

### Version 6.0.5.8

November 19, 2010

- WebBrain Sync
  - If there is a problem with the sync process, an automatic recovery is done using a retry process
  - Error messages are more relevant and provide advice on how to overcome issues
  - The speed of toolbar sync button animation is slower to be less distracting
  - Fixed: If a Thought icon file is missing, it causes the icon file to be removed from other Brains that sync with it
  - Fixed: Thoughts copied into a Brain from another Brain are not synced
  - Fixed: The message “No sync points found” occurs when a brain is synced immediately after creation
- Performance
  - Optimized display when large numbers of thoughts are visible in the plex at once
  - Improved robustness when recovering data from the backup
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Toolbar does not show Brain buttons when first opened, some buttons are enabled that should not be

### Version 6.0.5.7

- Auto-detection and repair of broken internal attachment links
- WebBrain Sync
  - Fixed: Status updates from server designated “pending” are sometimes incorrectly detected as errors
  - Improved error reporting
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Problems with pins in exported SiteBrains
  - Fixed: Setting dictionary does not apply to all open notes windows
  - Fixed: Some notes menus disappear after setting dictionary
  - Fixed: Problems with display of all day events
  - Fixed: Loops in Thought type hierarchies may not be caught and fixed

### Version 6.0.5.6

November 4, 2010

- Reporting on link types
  - Under the “All” dropdown in reports, there is a “Link Types” submenu
  - Selecting a link type shows all Thoughts connected by the selected type
- Google Calendar Sync
  - Support for exceptions to repeating events
    - If an exception has been added to a repeating event in your Google Calendar, the exception is reflected in PersonalBrain.
    - This change prevents a variety of other calendar sync related problems from occurring
  - Improved error handling and logging
- Replace Attachment Locations command
  - “Replace Attachment Locations” now can be undone and redone.
  - Fixed: Rebuilding the database after using the “Replace Attachments Locations” utility causes old locations to return.
- Repair Orphaned Attachments Utility Added
  - This command is for use if any of the following has happened:
    - An attachment was added but did not appear
    - An attachment was added and it is reported to be already attached but the thought with the attachment could not be activated
  - The command reviews all attachments in the brain’s database and repairs any missing references
  - If attachments are found whose original thought is unknown, they are added to the home thought
- Localizations
  - Updated translations for German
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Adding of attachments sometimes does not work correctly
  - Fixed: Certain unusual problems while syncing with WebBrain

- Fixed: “Today” in reports does not report today’s date if PersonalBrain has been open for longer than a day
- Fixed: Undo of set link type cannot be redone
- Fixed: Toolbar of reports panel does not wrap properly, causing the scrollbar of the reports window to appear off-screen in some cases
- Fixed: Problems with continuous database backup when there are more than 500,000 links
- Fixed: Backup file for the entries table may increase dramatically in size without an apparent cause

### Version 6.0.5.5

November 1, 2010

- Fixed: Various problems in version 6.0.5.4 with creating Thoughts and adding attachments
- Fixed: Various exceptions in log files when interacting with menus
- Fixed: In some cases, PersonalBrain may hang while attempting to close

### Version 6.0.5.4

October 29, 2010

- Modification info in reports
  - Reports has an option to show when changes were made for each Thought
  - This option also shows who made the changes if they were not made by the current user
- TeamBrain Services Support
  - Support for multiple users collaborating on a Brain requires a TeamBrain Services subscription (currently only available in private beta)
  - User information for each change is tracked through WebBrain
    - The Thought Details window shows which user made the last modification
- Localizations
  - Updated translations for Chinese, German and French
  - Japanese translation of tips
- Fixes
  - If there is a problem while syncing to WebBrain, additional troubleshooting information is provided so errors happening on the server can be easily found
  - Updated libraries for docking framework
  - Changed Windows graphics settings for broader compatibility
  - Fixed: Exceptions after closing brain
  - Fixed: Cannot open Brains created in PersonalBrain 4.X.
  - Fixed: Opening BrainZips under some circumstances causes an OutOfMemory error
  - Fixed: Problems due to missing Thought icons failing to load

### Version 6.0.5.1

October 15, 2010

- Better looking auto-hide icon
- Fixes:
  - Java 6 update 22 compatibility
  - If the activation file can’t be written to the normal program location, writes to a user specific location
  - Fixed: Running PersonalBrain using Java 5 does not work properly

### Version 6.0.5.0

October 12, 2010

- Activation Process
  - Activation can be done directly from PersonalBrain without using the browser
  - Recommendation dialog box does not appear unless requested
- Fixes
  - Fixed: A problem with the Chinese localization prevents selection of the activation file.
  - Fixed: Negative link widths cause the plex to stop responding

### Version 6.0.4.9

October 9, 2010

- Activation process clarified

- Fixes
  - If Thought names longer than 128 characters were in a Brain converted from version 5.5 and they were truncated, the missing portion is automatically recovered.
  - Fixed: Under rare circumstances pins cannot be created and Shift+right-click does not allow deleting
  - Fixed: Exception caused by missing "SendTo" folder on Windows XP

#### **Version 6.0.4.8**

- Updated German language resources
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Copy and paste of large numbers of Thoughts fails to display confirmation prompt
  - Fixed: Loading fails for Brains if the preference information has been corrupted

- Fixed: Problem loading pins with non-standard GUIDs created by imported data

- Brain Statistics
  - Includes total size of internal attachments
  - Improved formatting for large numbers of Thoughts and other items
- Fixed: Various problems on startup with certain Brains

#### **Version 6.0.4.3 (Release Candidate)**

September 29, 2010

- Miscellaneous Enhancements
  - Added commands to change thought privacy to the Edit menu
  - Displays the progress of background event processing when a brain is closing
  - The search results window displays using system colors
  - Double clicking an empty area of the attachments area shows the add attachment dialog
  - Attachment sorting preference is universal
- Outlook Integration
  - When a contact is added from Outlook, the company name is used for the Thought name if the name of a person is not available.
  - Fixed: Drag and drop of multiple items with the same name at once does not work
- WebBrain Sync Fixes
  - Fixed: Syncing of pins to WebBrain does not work properly and sometimes results in a loss of pins
  - Fixed: Default notes style information (in notes.css) is not used when accessed from WebBrain
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Types popup menu does not close when spacebar is pressed
  - Fixed: Improper XML files with duplicate tags and types cause a null exception
  - Fixed: Various issues with Type and Tag menus on Linux
  - Fixed: Problems with renaming brain after sync
  - Fixed: When a brain is moved from Windows to Mac OS and there are external attachments, their location is not displayed properly
  - Fixed: Right-clicking on an attachment should not start the rename process
  - Fixed: Deleting a tag does not remove it from the past thought list and pins display
  - Fixed: You shouldn't be able to assign a tag to a thought type
  - Fixed: If the set Thought color popup is open and you activate a different thought, it should disappear
  - Fixed: Pressing the spacebar to center active thought in expanded view does not work
  - Fixed: Confirm dialog can sometimes appear underneath the progress dialog when pasting, preventing confirmation
  - Fixed: Registration information is saved in the wrong location under Windows XP

#### **Version 6.0.4.2**

- Optimized background processing of events that update indexes after a large number of changes
- Miscellaneous Enhancements
  - Updated splash screen, icons for installer, .brain and .brainzip files
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Importing of large XML files fails
  - Fixed: Some brains cannot be converted to version 6 properly
  - Fixed: Some languages cause the preferences screen to hang
  - Fixed: .brain and .brainzip file extensions are sometimes not registered properly

#### **Version 6.0.4.1**

September 10, 2010

- WebBrain
  - Encrypted Sync
    - WebBrain synchronization is protected using 128-bit AES Encryption. (The same encryption used by the US government to protect classified information.)
    - Port 443 is used for encrypted syncs. If your firewall does not enable an SSL connection, you can disable encryption by going to Preferences > Advanced and typing "http://webbrain.com" as the WebBrain address (If no protocol is specified, https is the default)
- Mac OS X Specific Changes
  - Printing of notes
    - The ability to print notes has been added (Notes > File > Print)
  - Fixed (unverified): On some computers, PersonalBrain fails to shutdown
- Miscellaneous Enhancements
  - Multiple tag deletion
    - You can now select multiple tags at a time to delete them. Hold down control/command or shift to select multiple tags then click the delete button
  - Added a keyboard accelerator for details
  - System colors are used for the search panel and calendar – this makes the UI conform when themes such as "High contrast" are applied to the OS
  - When creating thoughts, tags and types can be selected using the keyboard (arrow keys, spacebar, and enter)
  - Updated French localization
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Problem with updating database that could cause errors when syncing (syskey column too short)
  - Fixed: Database error when syncing (null not allowed in EntryToObject > objected)
  - Fixed: sometimes deleting of a forgotten thought does not work when there are attachments present
  - Fixed: After closing a brain, the brain buttons are disabled
  - Fixed: when using keyboard to navigate through thought types/tags, list scrolls if necessary
  - Fixed: Thought GUID does not fit in the details window
  - Fixed: Deleting an attachment when there are multiple attachments with same location does not always delete the selected attachment
  - Tags panel is updated when preference colors are changed
  - Fixed: Tags count does not update when a tag is deleted
  - Fixed: The select attachment dialog may extend off-screen if there are many file templates present
  - Fixed: The text cursor position is altered when multiple notes editors are present and a change is made in one that affects another
  - Fixed: When a type is deleted, it does not disappear from the menu
  - Fixed: Floating notes windows always have spellchecking enabled

#### **Version 6.0.4.0**

- Fixed: Unlinking thoughts and dragging thoughts to change their relationship sometimes does not update the display

#### **Version 6.0.3.9**

- Improved Performance
  - Significant performance optimizations to the plex frontend and database backend
  - Responsiveness increased by up to 600% in large brains
  - Consistently smooth user interface responsiveness
- Updated German localization
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Mouseover highlighting of tag thoughts causes the user interface to pause
  - Fixed: Create BrainZip command recreates the continuous database backup unnecessarily
  - Fixed: Possible lockup of application caused by loading of images

### **Version 6.0.3.8**

- WebBrain Sync
  - Improved status/error handling
  - Added WebBrain terms notice to the synchronization dialog box
- Fixes
  - Fixed: The last change made to notes may be lost when a different Thought is activated or highlighted and then focus immediately returns to the original Thought
  - Fixed: Sorting of the character L with a stroke through it is incorrect
  - Fixed: The tag usage count does not fit if there are more than 999 occurrences
  - Fixed: Attachments can't be edited in floating Thought windows
  - Minor corrections in text resources

### **Version 6.0.3.7**

August 23, 2010

- Multiple Notes Windows
  - Notes for a Thought can be opened in a floating window
- UI Improvements
  - On Windows, floating tool windows for details, Thought, and notes, are shown with a less prominent title bar
- Fixes
  - Fixed: Sync does not initiate due to missing library
  - Fixed: If multiple attachments are selected, they are not remembered when the highlighted Thought changes

### **Version 6.0.3.6**

August 21, 2010

- WebBrain Sync
  - If an initial upload of a Brain is interrupted, the next time you sync PersonalBrain will offer to resume the previous upload
  - Fixed: Uploads of more than 2 GB do not work
- Precise Event Times
  - Event times can now be entered using the keyboard to set times precise to the minute
- Other Changes and Additions
  - Added accelerator for inserting date/time into notes (Ctrl+D).
  - Create Duplicate Child accelerator changed (Ctrl+Shift+D)
  - Updated German translation
- Fixes:
  - Updated notes editor component (fix for startup in German locale)
  - Adjusted Thought Window layout when name is on a separate row
  - Fixed: When assigning a new Brain GUID, the last completed sync date is not cleared
  - Fixed: OWL import does not inform user of the need to download the necessary libraries
  - Fixed: When a BrainZip is used to move a Brain from one computer to another, sometimes icons are not accurate until Thoughts are clicked
  - Fixed: When a BrainZip is being created, no progress dialog is shown
  - Various fixes for exceptions related to failing to load images for preview
  - Fixed: Loading of scaled images causes PB to hang

- Fixed: Scaled image files are not deleted when files are deleted
- Fixed: The selected attachment is lost during mouse-over of another Thought
- Fixed: Sorting attachments by date does not work
- Fixed: Overlap of text in attachments window
- Fixed: Past Thought list scroll button appears in the wrong place at startup
- Fixed: File length is not getting put into the database
- Fixed: When importing some MindManager files, notes are not imported
- Updated library for docking framework

### Version 6.0.3.5

August 8, 2010

- Keyboard Enhancements
  - The keyboard navigation highlight indicator updates the tools when the “Update tools on highlight of Thoughts” preference is enabled
  - Added new accelerators to toggle the following preferences: Update tools on highlight of Thoughts, Activate last created Thought, Copy/Cut/Paste notes as text
  - Fixed: Esc should not exit presentation mode if keyboard navigation is active
- Create Thought Dialog Changes
  - Fixed various problems with consistency, drawing, hiding, and showing of the types and tags pop-ups
  - Enter key can be used for OK even when keyboard focus is on type/tag button
  - Fixed: Sometimes the source thought is not indicated correctly by the link line
  - Fixed: Keyboard focus is not set to the name edit field sometimes
  - Fixed: Esc key does not work properly (green line remains and does not hide pop-ups for type/tag)
  - Fixed: Sometimes the Create Thought Dialog goes behind the main window
- Attachment Select Dialog
  - Enables sorting options
  - Sizes according to the number of attachments better
  - Allows single click to select an item
  - Allows keyboard selection of an item
- Attachment List Fixes
  - Fixed: Large images slow down performance
  - Fixed: Icons for images don't retain their correct aspect ratio
  - Fixed: Icons are not shown properly in Mac OS and Linux
- Other Changes and Additions
  - Thought Types window displays types hierarchically
  - When a message is added via drag and drop from Outlook with the Ctrl key held down and the message is made internal, notes are still added, just like when linking
  - Dragging to create links can be canceled by pressing Esc before releasing the mouse button
  - The Thought selection box can be resized
  - Clicking on a search result for an event activates the event in the calendar
  - Edit event dialog fits on a smaller screen
  - Thought tab uses two rows when there is a long thought name

- Transparent Brain Mode



- Provides truly seamless access to your Brain while you use any other application popping it out of a window and layering your Thoughts directly above other applications
- View your Brain on top of whatever else you are doing without obscuring a lot of information
- Click the icon in the upper right of the plex to enter transparent mode
- Miniature Brain Mode
  - Transparent mode lets you miniaturize your Brain to just the active thought so that you can always have your Thoughts at your fingertips while using just a few square inches of space
  - While in transparent mode, click the title bar (the Brain icon with the current Brain name in it at the top of the window) to toggle miniature mode
- New Create/Edit Thought Interface
  - When creating a thought, you can now set the tags and type of the thought at the time of creation
  - If you link to an existing Thought, you can set the type of the thought
  - The context command to rename a thought (accessible via F2) can now be used to both rename as well as set the type and tags
- Simple WebBrain Uploading
  - Publish your Brain to WebBrain with a single command
  - Your online Brain serves as a backup in case your computer hard drive crashes or you lose your laptop
  - Once your Brain is online, update it with changes without the need to re-send everything
- Synchronization Overview
  - Put a copy of your Brain on another computer and synchronize changes between computers via WebBrain
  - Make changes to your Brain on any machine at any time (even concurrently on multiple machines) and synchronize the changes across all instances of your Brain
  - Keep your Brain on your laptop and desktop machines, or home and work - anything you add or change to one copy will be automatically migrated to other
- Synchronization Setup
  - Upload to WebBrain
    - Create an account at [webbrain.com](http://webbrain.com)
    - Open your Brain and select File > Synchronize Brain with WebBrain
    - Note: You can continue working in your brain and allow sync to work in the background by closing the status window
  - Copy the Brain to another machine
    - After the sync has been completed, place a copy of your Brain on another machine (by copying the Brain file and folder or by using a BrainZip)
  - Sync at your convenience
    - To upload any changes that have been made and to receive any changes that have been made elsewhere, simply run the sync again
- Collaboration using Sync
  - Multiple users can all work in the same Brain and the changes each user makes will still be synchronized across the different copies via WebBrain
  - Currently, in order to facilitate this, all users must utilize the same WebBrain account as only the Brain owner is given permission to modify the Brain
- Sync Conflict Resolution
  - If you change the same object from different copies between syncs, the most recent change will override the others
  - If you delete an object from one brain but had made changes in a different copy since the last sync, that object will be reconstituted with the changes
- Tags
  - Tags can have notes and attachments
- System Changes
  - A completely revamped database, featuring increased speed and reliability, especially with large brains
  - Initial loading of a large brain is faster as are navigation and other actions
  - The new storage format is not backward compatible
  - Much smaller installation package download size
- Calendar Sync



- The built-in calendar can be synced with your Google Calendar via the File > Synchronize Calendar with Google Calendar command
- Changes made to your local Calendar will be reflected in Google Calendar and vice-versa.
- You can use the Google Calendar as an intermediate to sync with other calendars such as iCal and Outlook. Simply sync the Calendar with Google, then sync Google with your other calendar.

- Other Calendar Improvements
  - Events can be edited, deleted, added, and marked as complete via the context menu, which is now accessible from the list of event reminders and the calendar view itself
  - Multi event deleting and dismissing
- Localization
  - The user interface language is automatically set based on your system locale, however you can now change the language via Preferences > General
  - Selection title and rename title text can be localized
- User Interface
  - Menus reorganized and cleaned up
  - Menus are shorter as non-applicable menu items are automatically hidden
  - The following commands have been moved from the Thought menu to the attachment context menu: Open attachment with, Remove attachment, Move File Into/Out of Brain
  - Improved Mac OS X look and feel
  - The instant search text box and results windows can be resized by dragging the right edge. Double-click on the edge to reset to the default size
- Other Changes and Improvements
  - Images copied into the clipboard can now be pasted as attachments
  - Focus returns to search after close of properties window
  - The color/icon of thoughts in reports lists are updated when types are changed
  - Improved saving of window positions
    - Saves float window position even if docked
    - Other minor improvements
  - Added ability to set focus to search button via Tab key
  - Shift-select of items in reports is faster
  - Non-character based fonts are filtered out of the UI selection tools
- Fixes
